- Fees:** Make checks payable to Midwest Dressage Association (MDA)
- Class Fee:** \$18 horse must be entered in at least 1 class each day (excluding Fun Class) while on the grounds or pay NC fee of \$30/day not entered Equitation classes - \$10; Fun Class - \$5
- NonMDA member fee** \$20 **per show** or must be member at time of entry. Membership forms at www.midwestdressage.org (\$47/\$37)
- Office Fee:** \$5 per show (July Classic 1 is a single show, July Classic II constitutes a 2nd show)
- Late Entry Fee:** \$10 per show if accepted
- Non Compete Horse:** Horses who are on the show grounds but are not competing must submit entry form, provide Coggins, pay office fee and must enter in NC class **each day** on the grounds. NC fee is \$30/day. Accepted only if space permits.
- Change Fee:** \$10 per class any time after entry is submitted - includes change of rider, horse, test, or division
- Stabling & Tack:** \$35 each day Day 1: 2 pm Th to 6 pm Fri; Day 2: 6 pm Fri to 6 pm Sat; Day 3: 6pm Sat to 6 pm Sun or \$90 per weekend (Th 2 pm – Sun 5pm) Note: **Stabling required for all horses** on the show grounds.
- RV Hook-up:** available – payable directly to Win A Gin Farm, \$80/weekend - water & electric
- Return Check Fee:** \$30
- Shavings** available from Win A Gin Farm. Inquire at Win A Gin's InGate when you arrive

Refunds:

Entries:

Entries with current Coggins should be mailed to the Show Secretary with checks payable to MDA. Complete entries (current Coggins, all applicable signatures and full payment) will be accepted in the order received. Failure to submit a complete entry form will result in you being placed on the wait list. Entries must be postmarked on the Opening date or thereafter, up to and including the Closing date or until the show is full, whichever comes first. Show committee reserves the right to limit entries, limit the classes per horse, to add, divide or cancel classes/divisions or make whatever changes required by circumstances of the competition.

No faxes of entries will be accepted. No credit card payments can be accepted.

Fun Class – to be ridden at end of day. Fee - \$5. Class to be ridden as a group, in the warm-up ring. Each rider to be given a plastic mug filled with water, rider with most water left is winner. Money from class fees will be divided 60% to 1st place, 30% to 2nd, 10% to 3rd. No formal attire required however helmet /appropriate tack & footwear is required. Horse & rider must be entered in other classes at this show.

Confirmation & Ride Times:

Competitors will receive email confirmations and entries will be posted to www.showsecretary.com. Contact **entry show secretary** if your entry does not appear or if the classes listed are incorrect. Tentative ride times will be posted to the website approximately 7 days before show, but may change up until the day of the show. Check show program for confirmed times. Write clearly!

Arenas:

Showing in *two outdoor arenas* with excellent sand footing and drainage. One large outdoor warm up arena. All arenas are fenced. All Intro and Training level test 1 classes to be ridden in small arena. Arena size for Tr2, Tr3, and Tr4 maybe either small or large depending on scheduling. All First Level and above tests will be ridden in a large arena.

Dogs: All dogs must be leashed at all times. Please consider leaving them at home.

Food: Excellent hot food available onsite.

Coggins: Negative Coggins required for all horses within 12 months for MI horses & within 6 months for out-of-state horses. Coggins must be presented before horses can be unloaded. Name on Coggins must match name of horse on entry form.

Young Horses – all horses on the show grounds must be at least 3 years of age as of the show date.

Lame Horses – Horses which are eliminated by a judge for lameness are eliminated from all classes for the remainder of that day regardless of rider. No refunds.

Classes: Current USEF tests will be used. Shows will be conducted under USEF rules unless otherwise noted by show management. Jr. riders are defined as 21 years of age or younger as of 12/01/2010 according to the USEF standards. ASTM approved helmets must be worn by all riders at all times. Adults may sign a helmet waiver. Management has the right to combine or divide classes as needed. Horses may be shown in only two consecutive levels regardless of the number of riders sharing the horse. (Example: Intro & training level or training & first level etc.) **Horse may be ridden in only 3 classes per day- fun class and equitation do not count.** If more than 3 entries per day are included on entry form, show secretary will enter you in the first 3 classes listed. **Exception for horse shared by more than 1 rider – horse may be ridden in 4 classes per day.**

Awards: Each class awarded 8 ribbons. Additional Awards maybe given. See show program

Divisions: **AA** are Adult Amateurs in accordance with USEF1306. Riders are considered JR/YG riders until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 21. **OPEN** are those who in accordance with USEF GR1308 are professionals by taking any amount of money or other remuneration to ride, show, train, school or give riding lessons. If confused, please review USEF rules at www.usef.org/rules or contact Show Mgr. **Novice** designates horse or rider in their 1st or 2nd year of showing – please be honest as we may check.

MDA YearEnd Award Eligibility – In order for your scores to count toward MDA Year End Awards, you must be an MDA Member prior to earning the score. Save your tests. MDA Membership forms are available at www.midwestdressage.org. Adult memberships \$47, JR/YG Rider \$37, additional family members \$17.
